Tickets have been selling steadily for the Friday, May 19 performance of the Milwaukee Symphony Orchestra, under the direction of Andreas Delfs and featuring concertmaster Frank W. Almond on violin.

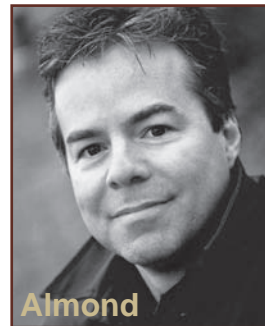

To date, about 150 tickets are left for the concert, which will be in the University Theater at 7:30 p.m.

The evening is a fundraiser for the University, with tickets at \$40. They are available through the Box Office, at (414) 410-4171. The event is being brought to Stritch through the generosity of trustee and benefactor Joan Steele Stein and the St. Joseph Regional Medical Center.

The program will include Tchaikovsky's Polonaise from the opera "Eugene Onegin," Henryk Wieniawski's Concerto No. 2 in D minor for Violin and Orchestra, Opus 22, and Brahms' Symphony No. 2 in D major, Opus 73.
