This year's Holiday Dinner has been moved from its usual Friday night to a Thursday to accommodate several scheduling concerns. The dinner will be held Thursday, Jan. 18, 2007, at 6 p.m. in the Sister Camille Kliebhan Conference Center. The service recognition portion of the evening will begin at 7:30 p.m.



The change was made in part to allow people from the College of Business who are traveling to Milwaukee to attend regional meetings on Jan. 17 and 18 to join in the festivities.

Also, undergraduate student orientation will be held on Friday, Jan. 19, and it would have been very difficult to accommodate the two events on campus on the same day.

Additionally, classes for the University's doctoral program are in session on Friday night, and in past years, people involved in the classes could not attend the Friday holiday dinner.

Flexible spending account forms are available through the Human Resources office and are due Dec. 13. Any insurance plan changes also are due Dec. 13.


