## PRESIDENTIAL SEARCH COMMITTEE FORMATION BEGINS; EMPLOYEES CAN SELF-NOMINATE USING FORM



The search for Cardinal Stritch University's next president is getting underway, beginning with the Board of Trustees interviewing search firms during the week of April 26. A firm will be selected on April 30.

The process of selecting a search firm is linked to the creation of an internal search committee, which will be actively involved in the presidential search. The entire presidential selection process will begin this June and end in May 2011 with the committee's recommendation to the Board of Trustees for approval.

All employees are invited to participate in this important search committee role by completing a self-nominating form. Three faculty and three staff members will be selected to join members of the board, who have also been invited to participate.

Beginning Friday, April 23, the self-nominating form will be available on My Stritch at <http://my.stritch.edu> under the "Employee Info" tab. Please complete the form and submit it to Elouise Baylor at [ebaylor@stritch.edu](mailto:ebaylor@stritch.edu) no later than 5 p.m. on Friday, May 7. The committee selection will be made by Friday, May 14.

A firm timeline of the entire presidential search will be announced once a search firm has been selected and begins their work. We will keep you regularly updated on the presidential search in The Troubadour.
